5. Items for Separate Vote

- a. Jordan Winn presentation regarding Nichols Hills city flag design brief and concepts.

Mr. Michael Taylor, Assistant City Manager, reported that Mr. Jordan Winn, partner and designer with Labor Division, and Mr. Shane Pate, City Manager, recently met and determined the flags he had were too generic for the City of Nichols Hills. Mr. Taylor stated that the City Council will have a joint meeting with the Nichols Hills Centennial Committee in the near future to discuss symbols that represent the City of Nichols Hills. Mr. Winn will have new concepts of proposed City flags to present to the Committee in the next six-eight weeks.

- b. Light show with drones.

Mr. Michael Taylor, Assistant City Manager, discussed with the Nichols Hills Centennial Committee having a drone light show for both the 250-Year Celebration of the United States, July 4, 2026, and the 100-Year Celebration of the City of Nichols Hills, possibly on September 29, 2029.
