Assistant City Manager Michael Taylor reviewed the events for the July 4th, 2026 celebration, beginning with the Ann Taylor 4th of July Parade, followed in the evening with food trucks, Mountain Smoke live music, face painting, balloon artist, stadium seating close to the gazebo in Kite Park, and a drone show which will be coordinated with music. The Methodist Church parking lot will be available for parking. Mr. Taylor will check into renting golf carts to shuttle people from parking areas to the event, and inflatable games. The event's activities and street closings will be posted in the *Town Talk*, Nichols Hills utility bills, Facebook, and the City's website.
